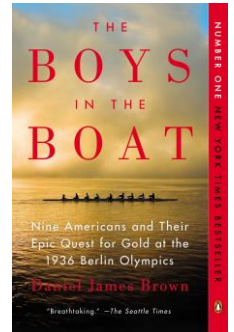

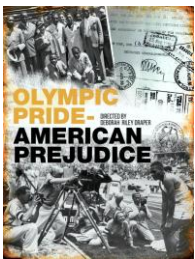


Documentary Films

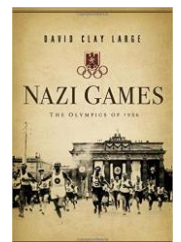
